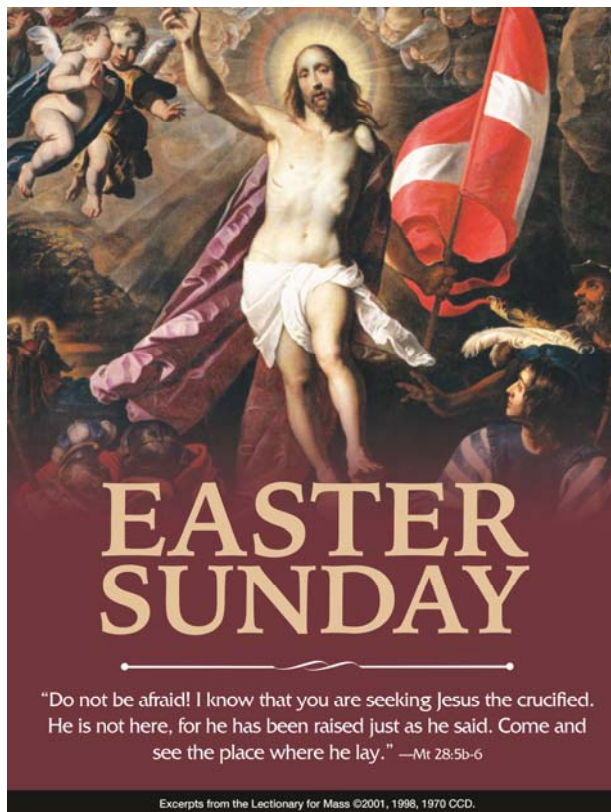

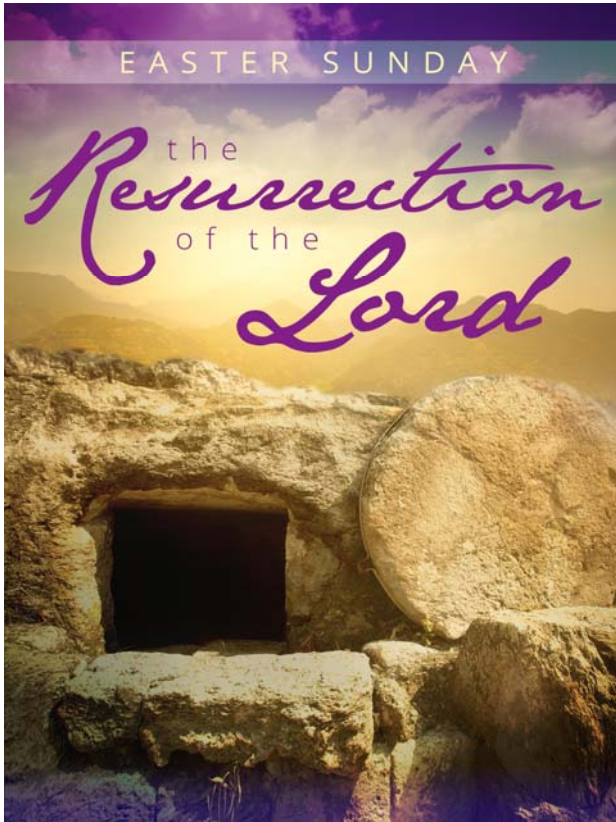

God bless you and thank you for being here today! Have a wonderful day and a great holiday in the Myrtle Beach area!

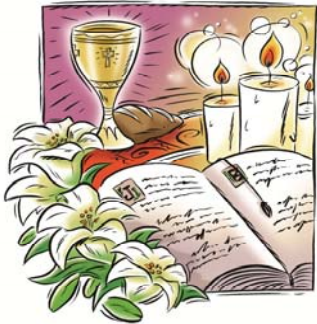

GUIDELINES FOR THE RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

As Catholics, we fully participate in the celebration of the Mass when we receive Holy Communion, the true Body and Blood of the Lord. Yet, we Catholics should receive Holy Communion only when we are living in communion with the Catholic Church and in the state of sanctifying grace and have made the appropriate fast from food and drink.

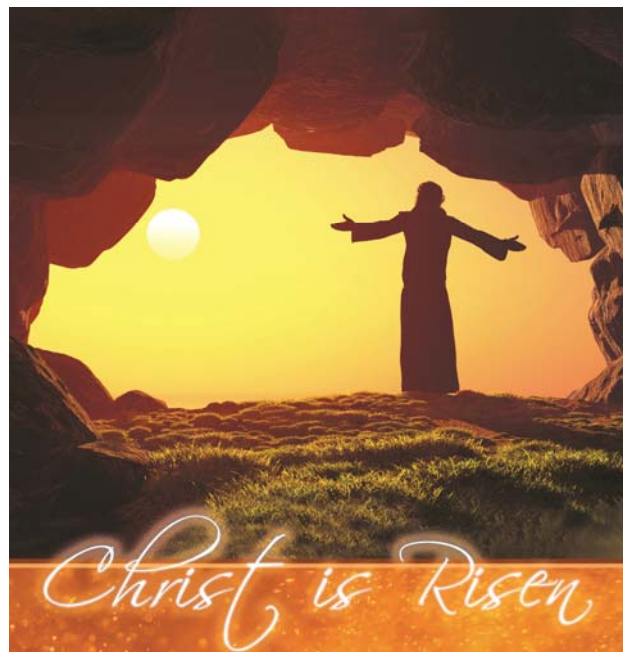
Because of the connection we draw between being in full communion with the Catholic Church and receiving Holy Communion, we cannot invite those who are not Catholic to share in Holy Communion with us. Still, we welcome all to this celebration of the Mass as our brothers and sisters, and pray that our common baptism and the action of the Holy Spirit will one day draw us closer "...that all may be one." (John 17:22)

The day of resurrection! Earth, spread the news abroad; the Paschal feast of gladness, the Paschal feast of God. From death to life eternal, from earth to heaven's height, our Savior Christ has brought us, the glorious Lord of Light.

Our hearts be free from evil, that we may see aright the Savior resurrected in his eternal light; and hear his message plainly, delivered calm and clear; "Rejoice with me in triumph, be glad and do not fear."

His love is everlasting; His mercies never cease; the resurrected Savior, will all our joys increase. He'll keep us in his favor, supplying holy grace, to all his pilgrim people who seek his heavenly place.

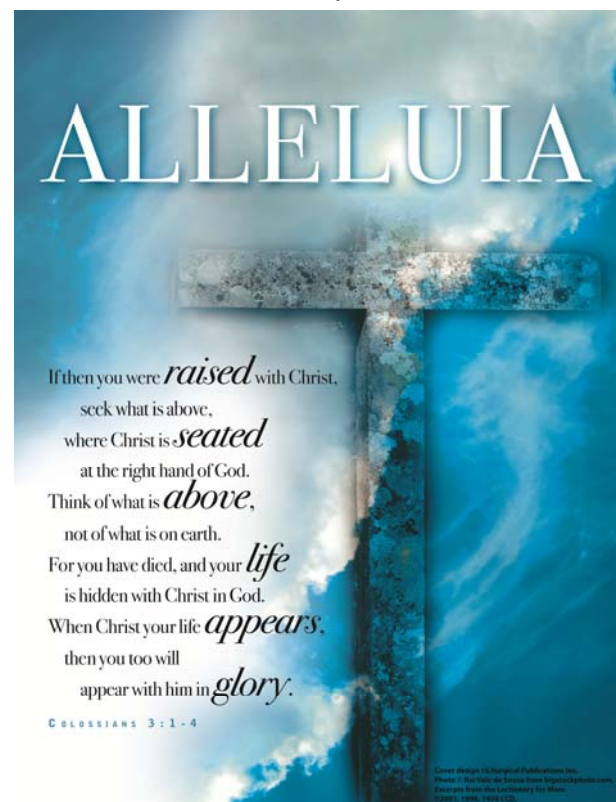

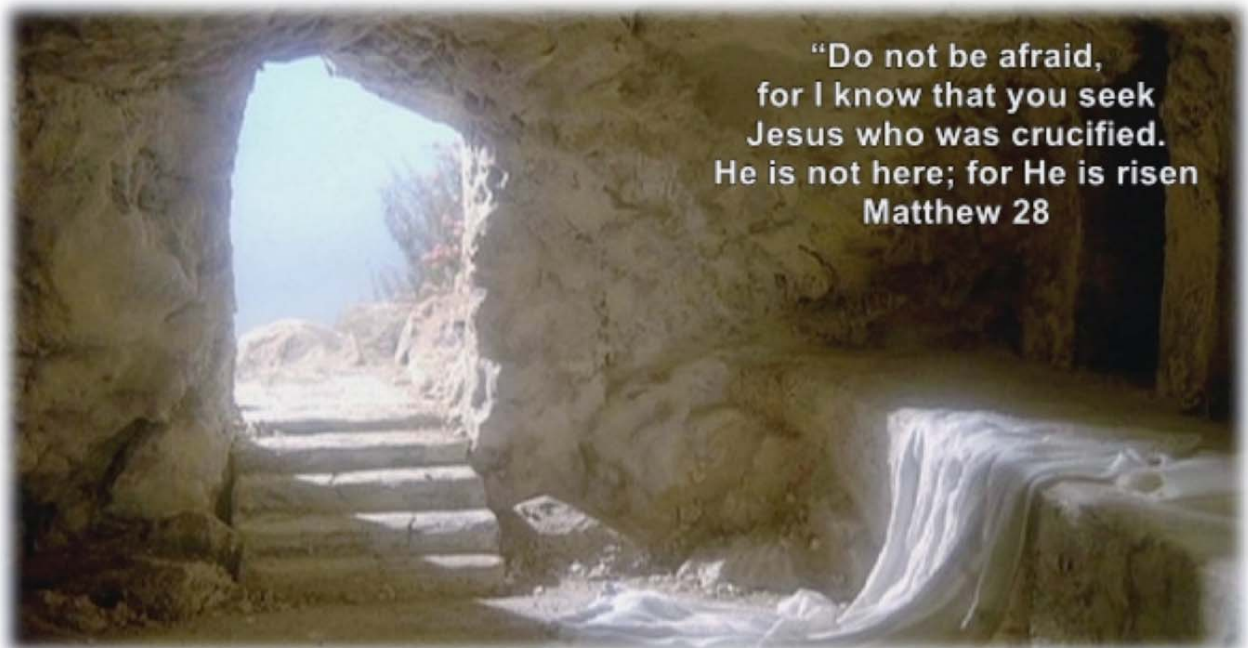

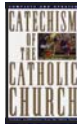
