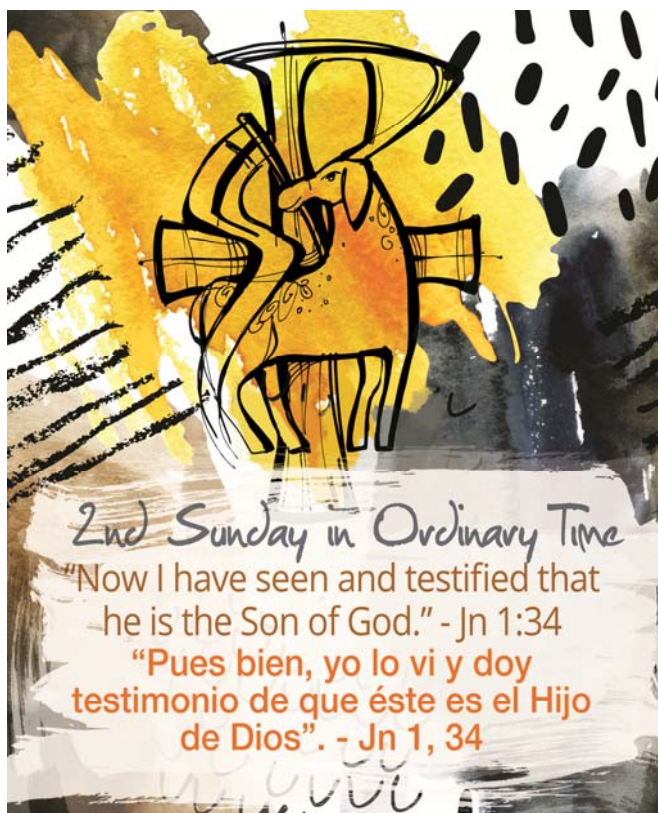

### GUIDELINES FOR THE RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

Still, we welcome all to this celebration of the Mass as our brothers and sisters, and pray that our common baptism and the action of the Holy Spirit will one day draw us closer “...that all may be one.” (John 17:22)

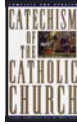
