Dear Friends in Christ,

Each year on August 15th, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, in which we recall that the Blessed Virgin Mary did not suffer death as we know it, but rather, at the end of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heaven. This same feast is known in the Christian east as the Dormition of the Theotokos, or the "Falling Asleep of the Mother of God."

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin has been part of the Christian faith from the earliest days of the Church, as attested by writings of the Church Fathers and Doctors, as well as the liturgical traditions of both east and west. But it was not defined formally as dogma until the first of November, 1950, when Pope Pius XII wrote in *Munificentissimus Deus*, or *The Most Bountiful God*: "By the authority of our Lord Jesus Christ, of the Blessed Apostles Peter and Paul, and by our own authority, we pronounce, declare, and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma: that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory."

That the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God, should not suffer the corruption of the body after death is a sign of the infinite bounty and generosity of God, and is truly fitting for Mary, who came into the world through the Immaculate Conception. She who was free from the stain of Original Sin and from all actual sin did not suffer the pains and the corruption of death, which are the wages of sin, but rather fell peacefully into the rest of eternal sleep, and immediately entered body and soul into Heaven.

It is a sad fact for us who have been redeemed, but yet are still fallen and suffer from the effects of sin, that when our earthly course is run, we will experience death and the corruption of the body. But through Christ Jesus, the victory over sin and death is won, and the grave is not the end. We, too, can join the Blessed Virgin Mary and all the saints in light. This is the very purpose and essence of our life in the Church: being a Christian is to come to know and serve God in this world so that, when we experience death, we might live with him eternally in the glory of Heaven.

Please remember that the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a Holy Day of Obligation, and all Catholics who are not impeded by sickness are expected to come to Mass. Here at St. Andrew's we will celebrate the Vigil Mass of the Assumption on Tuesday the 14th at 7 p.m., and on Wednesday the 15th at 6:30 a.m. and again at noon, as well as at 7 p.m. in Spanish. Please join us that day to celebrate the mercy and love of our bountiful God, who welcomed the Blessed Virgin Mary body and soul into heaven, and to pray through her powerful intercession, that we might join them when our life on earth comes to its end.

Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death.








GOSPEL MEDITATION

ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING
OF SCRIPTURE

Have you ever approached a hushed group and were certain they were talking about you? It's an uncomfortable feeling to catch people murmuring about what you did, said, or didn't do. It breeds division and exclusion. In today's Gospel, Jesus invites us to just the opposite.

The reading opens with the crowds "murmuring" their doubts about Jesus after he has proclaimed himself the Bread of Life. "Is this not Jesus, the son of Joseph? how can he say 'I have come down from heaven?'" In his response, Jesus brings up the Israelites and the manna God brought them in the desert. If you turn back to the story in Exodus, you'll see another similar word: murmuring. As the going got tough, the Israelites doubted Moses and God's plan to protect and care for them as a chosen people. Here, Jesus proposes a difficult theological concept. Jesus himself is "the living bread" and "flesh for the life of the world." This is not an exclusive concept. "Everyone who listens to my Father and learns from him comes to me." Why? Because "the Father who sent me draw[s] him." The next time you're at Mass, take a few moments to watch the communion line. Young and old, families and singles, diverse races and cultures and stories? we are all drawn to the Eucharistic table. Catholic doctrine may require faith, but it is a faith possible for anyone who seeks truth. Christianity does not hide behind locked doors in an exclusive clubhouse, whispering behind the backs of nonbelievers. Jesus compels us to share the love of God the Father for his children, that we one day be joined with Him and "live forever."




MEDITACIÓN EVANGÉLICO - ALENTAR

ENTENDIMIENTO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA
ESCRITURA (Gospel Meditation)

Los judíos murmuraban porque Jesús había dicho: "Yo soy el pan que ha bajado del cielo". Y decían: Conocemos a su padre y a su madre, ¿no es cierto? Él no es sino Jesús, el hijo de José, ¿Cómo puede decir que ha bajado del cielo". (Juan 6:41-42). En este Evangelio, seguimos leyendo el discurso del pan de vida. Jesús mismo nos enseña el misterio de que él es el Pan de vida. Él es el único que se da de sí mismo a nosotros para darnos vida eterna. Sin embargo, ante la falta de fe de los que murmuraban ya que dicen saber el origen de su familia, conocían a sus padres y a sus amigos. Se dejaban llevar por la simple apariencia de la familia, sabían que era hijo de José y de María. Ellos, no veían más allá, no escuchaban que Jesús hablaba de su Padre del cielo. ¡Estaban ciegos y sordos a la gracia de Dios!

En nuestra vida, en nuestro caminar como discípulos de Jesús. ¿En que se basa nuestra fe, cómo la alimentamos? ¿Qué nos atrae de Él, de sus enseñanzas? "En consecuencia, toda la celebración litúrgica, por ser obra de Cristo sacerdote y de su Cuerpo, que es la Iglesia, es acción sagrada por excelencia, cuya eficacia, con el mismo título y en el mismo grado, no la iguala ninguna otra acción de la Iglesia. Jesús es el Pan de vida". (Vaticano II, Sacrosanctum Concilium 7). Sin embargo, el reto es no criticar o murmurar en contra de la Iglesia y su tradición apostólica. Creer y vivir el misterio del pan de vida, es ser como Jesús, darse sin medida a los que lo necesiten.

Yo soy el pan vivo que ha bajado del cielo; el que coma de este pan vivirá para siempre.

— Juan 6:51

FORTELECIDOS POR EL PAN DE VIDA

Hoy retomamos el discurso sobre el “Pan de Vida” del Evangelio según san Juan que comenzó hace dos semanas. Juan alude a los ancestros de los judíos que comieron el maná en el desierto. Hoy pensaríamos sobre todo en el pueblo de Israel caminando por el desierto, pero los judíos fieles también conocían el relato de Elías que escuchamos hoy. Elías comió y bebió en el desierto, y con la fuerza de aquel alimento, el ángel del Señor lo envió en su viaje de cuarenta días y cuarenta noches (la cifra bíblica que simboliza un tiempo de preparación). De la misma manera que el alimento que recibió Elías en el desierto, Jesús le dice a su público que él es pan para la vida del mundo. Es muy importante que sigamos escuchando a Jesús después de su promesa de vida eterna, sin duda es una promesa maravillosa, pero esta “recompensa” no es la única razón para darnos un festín con el Pan de Vida. También vamos a la mesa con el fin de recibir fuerzas para el camino de la misión, de manera que el mundo entero pueda tener vida en la plenitud de Cristo. Si hemos comido el pan de vida, estamos obligados a servir a todos.

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

En 1973 Juan A. Espinosa escribió la canción “Santa María del Camino” con la cual invita a la Madre de Dios a caminar con sus hermanos y hermanas en la fe. La canción reta al creyente a caminar a pesar de lo difícil que puede ser y a luchar por los cambios que sólo el Reino de Dios puede realizar. En todo esto María es invitada a caminar con el creyente.

En esta semana recordamos la Asunción de María al cielo, y lo hacemos reconociendo que además de ser Madre de Dios y madre nuestra, ella también es nuestra hermana y compañera en el camino de la fe. Ella ha llegado a la meta de nuestra peregrinación y lo ha hecho en cuerpo y alma por un privilegio singular. Nosotros también lo haremos en los últimos días cuando nuestro cuerpo resucite para unirse con nuestra alma.
