Dear Friends in Christ,

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family, which is celebrated each year on the Sunday during the Octave of Christmas, or on December 30th if no Sunday falls between Christmas and New Year's Day. The Holy Family of course refers to the family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, and this feast reminds us that this family serves as a model for all families: husband, wife, and child, together in a mutual relation of care, service, obedience, and self-gift.

This model of the family is absolutely essential if societies are to know true human flourishing. Of course, sometimes due to circumstances beyond our control, not every family perfectly shows forth this model (parents may pass away while they still have young children, some husbands and wives never conceive, etc.), but it is important that this model of the family remain as our model, the image we hold up to emulate and seek to embody. It is more and more common today to say that this image of husband, wife, and children is simply one of many possible equally valid and equally healthy family models, and that to hold this model up as an example is discriminatory or judgmental. But these criticisms are grounded not in an understanding of our created nature, but in the idolatry of the self and self-will, which claims that whatever I want, whatever makes me feel good, must by that fact alone be good and acceptable. This understanding confuses self-will for freedom, and so is unwilling to accept any boundaries if they are contrary to my desires and will, even when those desires are obviously contrary to our created, embodied, biological nature.

This idolatry of false freedom and the self shows itself in many ways across our culture, and the family is no exception. One example is the common cultural acceptance of a woman conceiving a child through artificial means with gametes sold to a clinic by an anonymous male. This practice dissociates marital love from the procreative act, denies the child the right to know their biological father and his family, and reduces the child conceived to a product of technology. When this method is acceptable, a child becomes not a gift from God but an object, a lifestyle choice.

Dear friends, God made us to live as family for one another, and we cannot reject the way God has made us and expect to thrive. We cannot reject the Christian family. Children need their father. Children need their mother. Husbands and wives need one another. And they all need each other to give themselves to and for the other, for their mutual benefit in this world, and for their spiritual journey toward the next. If we are ever tempted to forget this fact and accept the various models of family life the world suggests to us, let us pray to the Holy Family, that through the intercession of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, we will hold fast to the life-giving truth of the Gospel, and strive to live our family life in service, fidelity, perseverance, and self-giving love.

St. Andrew Catholic Church will present a sexual abuse prevention program, Teaching Touching Safety, to our students on January 23, 2019, with a make-up date of January 30, 2019. This program is provided to us by the Diocese of Charleston and is a part of our ongoing effort to help create and maintain safe environments for all children and youth in our care.

The scheduled lesson is being offered to all students at Saint Andrew Catholic Church. As parents, you have the right to choose whether your student participates in the program. We encourage you to read the "overview" and "lesson plan" assigned to your child's age group to understand exactly what your child will be taught.

It is important to note, this is basic prevention education and is in no way to be considered sex education or education on private body parts. Neither of these components fall within our educational mandate to provide your child with the information needed to keep them safe from those who would do them harm.

If you wish to "opt" your child out of the prevention education session, please complete the "opt-out" form at the bottom of this page and return it to your child's teacher no later than January 16, 2019

# IGLESIA CATÓLICA DE SAN ANDRÉS

30 de diciembre de 2018

Queridos amigos en Cristo,

Este domingo celebramos la fiesta de la Sagrada Familia, que se celebra cada año el domingo durante la Octava de Navidad, o el 30 de diciembre si no hay domingo entre Navidad y Año Nuevo. La Sagrada Familia, por supuesto, se refiere a la familia de Jesús, María y José, y esta fiesta nos recuerda que esta familia sirve como modelo para todas las familias: esposo, esposa y niño, juntos en una relación mutua de cuidado, servicio, La obediencia y el auto-don.

Este modelo de familia es absolutamente esencial para que las sociedades conozcan el verdadero florecimiento humano. Por supuesto, a veces, debido a circunstancias fuera de nuestro control, no todas las familias muestran perfectamente este modelo (los padres pueden fallecer mientras aún tienen hijos pequeños, algunos esposos y esposas nunca conciben, etc.), pero es importante que este modelo de la familia sigue siendo nuestro modelo, la imagen que simulamos y buscamos encarnar. Hoy en día es cada vez más común decir que esta imagen de esposo, esposa e hijos es simplemente uno de los muchos posibles modelos familiares igualmente válidos e igualmente sanos, y que sostener este modelo como ejemplo es discriminatorio o crítico. Pero estas críticas no se basan en una comprensión de nuestra naturaleza creada, sino en la idolatría del yo y la voluntad propia, que afirma que lo que quiera, lo que me haga sentir bien, debe ser bueno y aceptable solo con ese hecho. Esta comprensión confunde la voluntad propia de la libertad y, por lo tanto, no está dispuesta a aceptar límites si son contrarios a mis deseos y voluntad, incluso cuando esos deseos son obviamente contrarios a nuestra naturaleza creada, encarnada y biológica.

Esta idolatría de la libertad falsa y el yo se manifiesta de muchas maneras en toda nuestra cultura, y la familia no es una excepción. Un ejemplo es la aceptación cultural común de una mujer que concibe a un niño por medios artificiales con gametos vendidos a una clínica por un hombre anónimo. Esta práctica disocia el amor conyugal del acto procreativo, niega al niño el derecho a conocer a su padre biológico y su familia, y reduce al niño concebido a un producto de la tecnología. Cuando este método es aceptable, un niño no se convierte en un regalo de Dios sino en un objeto, en una elección de estilo de vida.

Queridos amigos, Dios nos hizo vivir en familia unos con otros, y no podemos rechazar la forma en que Dios nos ha hecho y esperar prosperar. No podemos rechazar a la familia cristiana. Los niños necesitan a su padre. Los niños necesitan a su madre. Los esposos y las esposas se necesitan mutuamente. Y todos se necesitan el uno al otro para entregarse al prójimo y para el otro, para su beneficio mutuo en este mundo y para su viaje espiritual hacia el próximo. Si alguna vez nos sentimos tentados a olvidar este hecho y aceptar los diversos modelos de vida familiar que el mundo nos sugiere, oremos a la Sagrada Familia, para que a través de la intercesión de Jesús, María y José, nos mantengamos firmes en la vida. - Dar la verdad del Evangelio y esforzarnos por vivir nuestra vida familiar en servicio, fidelidad, perseverancia y amor abnegado.

La idea, el sueño y la realidad de lo que es familia es tan fuerte y perdurable que lo usamos para describir lo mejor de las relaciones humanas. Hablamos de una familia de naciones, de nuestra familia eclesial y parroquial. El mejor halago que podemos dar a un amigo o amable anfitrión es decirle que nos sentimos como en casa con su compañía, que nos sentimos parte de la familia.

Las familias son el primer crisol en el que se prueba y se fortalece el amor. Jesús mismo fue una de tres personas que vivía a la sombra del otro.
