Dear Friends in Christ,

We are now into February and the winter flu season is well underway. The Center for Disease Control estimates that nearly 7 million people have contracted the flu thus far, and the number of cases is rising each day. And although we usually consider the flu to be something of a minor and passing illness, we should remember that tens of thousands of people have required hospitalization for the flu this year, and last year an estimated 80,000 people died from the flu, mostly children and the elderly. The CDC expects this flu season to continue for weeks to come, and recommends vaccination and other precautionary measures.

There are a number of precautions that we can take as the people of St. Andrew's in order to help slow the spread of the flu. Primarily, we need to be mindful concerning our participation in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. First, we should remember that we are under no obligation to attend Mass, even on Sunday, if we are suffering from debilitating illness, especially a dangerous and contagious illness such as the flu. So, if you do contract the flu this season, please consider staying at home until your illness has passed and you are no longer contagious. When we are gathered here in the church, we should remember a few simple rules. According to the CDC, "a person might spread the flu virus by droplets from a cough, sneeze or talking, but one may also get the flu by touching a surface or object that has the flu virus on it and then touching their own mouth or nose." We should always cover our mouth and nose when we sneeze and cough, especially when we are in a public place such as the church, and remember to frequently and thoroughly wash our hands, and avoid touching our eyes, mouth, or nose.

This past week, our Bishop Robert instructed pastors throughout the Diocese of Charleston to consider adopting several precautionary measures in order to help prevent the spread of the flu. One of these recommendations is to suspend temporarily the Sign of Peace shared among the people during the Communion Rite at Mass. And so, and in accordance with the recommendation of our Bishop Robert, here at St. Andrew's we shall suspend for the remainder of the flu season the Sign of Peace among the people during the Communion Rite. In practice, this will mean that, when it is time for the Sign of Peace, the celebrating priest will offer the Sign of Peace to the people, saying, "The Peace of the Lord be with you always," to which the people reply as usual, "And with your spirit." However, the deacon will not say, "Let us offer each other the sign of peace." Rather, we will immediately begin the Agnus Dei, the Lamb of God. It is our hope that by eliminating the physical contact of the handshake we can inhibit the spread of the flu virus. While this might feel awkward at first, as if we are being disrespectful to our brothers and sisters by ignoring them when we usually greet them, we should remember that the true Sign of Peace here is offered by Christ the Lord himself, both Priest and Victim, in the ritual gesture of the priest. We will resume the exchange of the Sign of Peace among the people when the flu season has passed.

May he who is the source of all health and happiness guide you and protect you throughout this flu season, and may the Peace of the Lord be with you always.

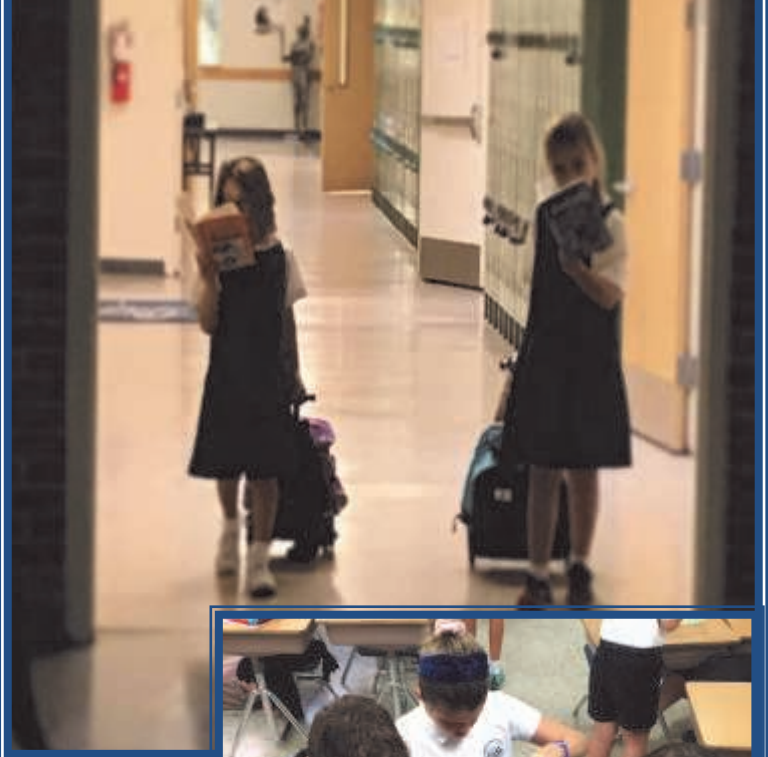

# IGLESIA CATÓLICA DE SAN ANDRÉS

3 de febrero de 2019

Queridos amigos en Cristo,

Estamos a comienzo de febrero, y la temporada de la gripe de invierno está en marcha. El Centro para el Control de Enfermedades estima que casi 7 millones de personas han contraído la gripe hasta el momento, y el número de casos aumenta cada día. Y aunque generalmente consideramos que la gripe es una enfermedad menor y pasajera, debemos recordar que decenas de miles de personas han requerido hospitalización por la gripe este año, y el año pasado se estima que 80,000 personas murieron a causa de la gripe, en su mayoría niños y los ancianos. El CDC espera que la temporada de la gripe continúe durante las próximas semanas, y recomienda la vacunación y otras medidas de precaución.

Hay una serie de precauciones que podemos tomar como feligreses de St. Andrew para ayudar a frenar la propagación de la gripe. Principalmente, debemos ser conscientes de nuestra participación en el Santo Sacrificio de la Misa. Primero, debemos recordar que no tenemos la obligación de asistir a la Misa, ni siquiera los domingos, si padecemos una enfermedad debilitante, especialmente una enfermedad peligrosa y contagiosa. Enfermedades como la gripe. Entonces, si contrae la gripe esta temporada, considere quedarse en casa hasta que su enfermedad haya pasado y ya no sea contagioso. Cuando estamos reunidos aquí en la iglesia, debemos recordar algunas reglas simples. Según los CDC, "una persona puede propagar el virus de la gripe por gotitas de tos, estornudar o hablar, pero también puede contraer la gripe al tocar una superficie u objeto que tiene el virus de la gripe y luego tocar su propia boca o nariz ". Siempre debemos taparnos la boca y la nariz cuando estornudamos y tosemos, especialmente cuando estamos en un lugar público como la iglesia, y recordemos lavarnos las manos con frecuencia y por completo, y evitar tocarnos los ojos, la boca o la nariz. .

La semana pasada, nuestro obispo Robert instruyó a los pastores de la Diócesis de Charleston a considerar de varias medidas de precaución para ayudar a prevenir la propagación de la gripe. Una de estas recomendaciones es suspender temporalmente el Signo de la Paz compartido entre las feligreses durante el Rito de Comunión en la Misa. Y así, y de acuerdo con la recomendación de nuestro Obispo Robert, aquí en St. Andrew's suspenderemos por el resto de la temporada de la gripe el Signo de la Paz entre las personas durante el Rito de Comunión. En la práctica, esto significará que, cuando llegue el momento de la Señal de la Paz, el sacerdote celebrador ofrecerá la Señal de la Paz al pueblo, diciendo: "La paz del Señor esté con usted siempre", a lo que la gente responde. como de costumbre, "Y con tu espíritu". Sin embargo, el diácono no dirá: "Vamos a ofrecernos el signo de paz". Más bien, comenzaremos de inmediato el Agnus Dei, el Cordero de Dios. Esperamos que al eliminar el contacto físico del apretón de manos podamos inhibir la propagación del virus de la gripe. Si bien esto puede parecer incómodo al principio, como si no estuviéramos siendo irrespetuosos con nuestros hermanos y hermanas al ignorarlos cuando solemos saludarlos, debemos recordar que el verdadero signo de paz aquí es ofrecido por Cristo, el mismo Señor, tanto sacerdote como víctima. , en el gesto ritual del sacerdote. Retomaremos el intercambio del Signo de la Paz entre la gente cuando haya pasado la temporada de gripe.

Que el que es la fuente de toda la salud y la felicidad lo guíe y proteja a lo largo de esta temporada de gripe, y que la Paz del Señor esté con usted siempre.
