Dear friends in Christ,

This Tuesday, January 22nd, the Church in the United States will observe a Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. This annual observance is part of the Church's response to the tragedy in our country of abortion-on-demand, a practice that has resulted in the murder of over 60 million unborn children since the Supreme Court decisions in *Roe v Wade* and *Doe v Bolton*, issued on January 22, 1973.

The cruelty and barbarism of abortion are obvious, as any photograph of an aborted fetus makes plain. However, despite this cruelty, many of our fellow citizens have come to think of abortion as an almost sacred right, and they defend it with a fanatical devotion. This raises an important question. Why should— or better, how could— anyone fight to defend so brutal a practice? This commitment to abortion stems from a distorted notion of freedom which idolizes the self and the power of self-will. This false freedom sees any encumbrance or trammel to total self-will as an attack, and this extends even to the relationship of mother and child. For a woman to be free, this false freedom asserts, she must have an absolute right to destroy the child in her womb if she believes it to be a threat to her autonomy. Otherwise, she cannot be free. Any reason to abort will do, or even no reason at all. This idea of freedom is demonic in its both origin and result, and it is a horror and tragedy that it should be considered constitutionally protected in our country. And so, each year on January 22nd the Church observes this Day of Prayer in hopes that the hearts and minds of our fellow citizens will be converted away from this idolatry and false freedom, and that we might together foster a culture, which cherishes all life, especially the most vulnerable.

The Church calls each of us to participate in this Day of Prayer through the penitential practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Resolve now to give yourself in some way to this prayer and penance for an end to the evil of abortion in our country.

In *Evangelium Vitae*, The Gospel of Life, Saint John Paul II wrote, "A great prayer for life is urgently needed, a prayer which will rise up throughout the world. Through special initiatives and in daily prayer, may an impassioned plea rise to God, the Creator and lover of life, from every Christian community, from every group and association, from every family and from the heart of every believer." This Tuesday, may all our hearts and voices be lifted up in an impassioned plea to our Father, that abortion may cease, that those who support abortion on demand may experience a conversion of mind and heart, that mothers and families may always be supported, and for the Lord's mercy upon us all.

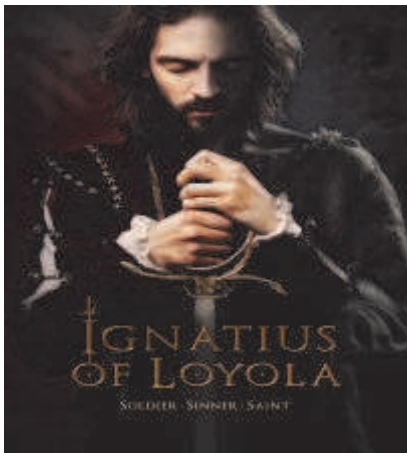

# IGLESIA CATÓLICA DE SAN ANDRÉS

20 de enero de 2019

Queridos amigos en Cristo,

Este martes, 22 de enero, la Iglesia en los Estados Unidos celebrará un Día de oración por la protección legal de los niños no nacidos. Esta observancia anual es parte de la respuesta de la Iglesia a la tragedia en nuestro país del aborto a pedido, una práctica que ha resultado en el asesinato de más de 60 millones de niños no nacidos desde las decisiones de la Corte Suprema en *Roe v Wade* y *Doe v Bolton*, emitido el 22 de enero de 1973.

La crueldad y la barbarie del aborto son obvias, como lo demuestra cualquier fotografía de un feto abortado. Sin embargo, a pesar de esta crueldad, muchos de nuestros conciudadanos han llegado a pensar que el aborto es un derecho casi sagrado, y lo defienden con una devoción fanática. Esto plantea una cuestión importante. ¿Por qué debería, o mejor, cómo podría alguien pelear para defender una práctica tan brutal? Este compromiso con el aborto se deriva de una noción distorsionada de libertad que idolatra el yo y el poder de la propia voluntad. Esta libertad falsa ve cualquier estorbo o obstáculo para la total voluntad propia como un ataque, y esto se extiende incluso a la relación de madre e hijo. Para que una mujer sea libre, afirma esta libertad falsa, debe tener el derecho absoluto de destruir al niño en su vientre si cree que es una amenaza para su autonomía. De lo contrario, ella no puede ser libre. Cualquier razón para abortar lo hará, o incluso ninguna razón en absoluto. Esta idea de libertad es demoníaca tanto en su origen como en su resultado, y es un horror y una tragedia que se la considere constitucionalmente protegida en nuestro país. Y así, cada año, el 22 de enero, la Iglesia observa este Día de Oración con la esperanza de que los corazones y las mentes de nuestros conciudadanos se conviertan fuera de esta idolatría y falsa libertad, y que juntos podamos fomentar una cultura que valore toda la vida, especialmente los más vulnerables.

La Iglesia nos llama a cada uno de nosotros a participar en este Día de oración a través de las prácticas penitenciales de oración, ayuno y limosna. Resuélvete ahora a entregarte de alguna manera a esta oración y penitencia para acabar con el mal del aborto en nuestro país.

En *Evangelium Vitae*, El Evangelio de la vida, San Juan Pablo II escribió: "Se necesita con urgencia una gran oración por la vida, una oración que surgirá en todo el mundo. "A través de iniciativas especiales y en la oración diaria, puede surgir una súplica apasionada a Dios, el Creador y amante de la vida, de cada comunidad cristiana, de cada grupo y asociación, de cada familia y del corazón de cada creyente". Este martes de mayo todos nuestros corazones y voces se elevan en una apasionada súplica a nuestro Padre, que cese el aborto, que aquellos que apoyan el aborto a pedido puedan experimentar una conversión de mente y corazón, que las madres y las familias siempre puedan ser apoyadas, y para el Señor Misericordia de todos nosotros.

### UN DIOS VISIBLE

Nos resulta difícil transmitir ideas a la gente a menos que le mostremos algo, que le ilustremos lo que queremos decir. Dios, que es invisible y verdaderamente más allá del entendimiento humano, aparentemente tiene la misma dificultad. La gente quiere ver, no solamente quiere escuchar una idea. Por eso Dios nos dio a Jesucristo, Dios hecho visible en el mundo.

En las semanas recientes hemos visto cómo al nacer Jesús es mostrado a los pastores y a los Reyes Magos, y luego empezó su "vida pública" en su bautismo con Juan. El Evangelio de hoy nos habla de su "primer signo", que es proveer vino para los invitados a la boda en Caná.

Por supuesto, hasta a Jesús, que es Dios hecho visible, no siempre se le entendía en su tiempo y ni siquiera ahora. Por lo tanto, tenemos que considerar lo que vemos: la pobreza y simplicidad de su nacimiento, su humildad y franqueza ante Juan Bautista, su amabilidad y compasión hacia las personas en sus problemas ordinarios, como la falta de vino en una boda. Pero al conocer a Jesús conocemos a Dios.

### TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

En 1502 el Fraile Nicolás de Ovando y doce franciscanos dieron inicio a la evangelización de América en la República Dominicana. Ellos fueron enviados por los reyes españoles con el mandato de convertir a los nativos "sin les hacer fuerza alguna".

Con los misioneros llegaron Alfonso y Antonio Trejo quienes traían con ellos un cuadro de la Virgen María bajo la advocación de Nuestra Señora de la Altagracia. Ellos la llevaron a Higüey, donde en 1572 se le construyó su primer santuario. Poco a poco esta pequeña imagen se convirtió en la Reina del corazón de los dominicanos.

María observa dulcemente a su recién nacido quien yace sobre las pajas. Está coronada y lleva puesto un manto azul rociado de estrellas y un escapulario blanco. Lleva una aureola hecha de doce estrellas. En una esquina de la imagen san José también observa al niño por encima del hombro derecho de María.

El 25 de enero del 1979 Juan Pablo II la coronó por ser la primera evangelizadora del continente Americano. Con ella los doce misioneros trajeron la Alta Gracia de Jesucristo a nuestras tierras.
