Dear Friends in Christ,

This Wednesday, the 4th of July, we in the United States will celebrate Independence Day, the day each year when we remember and celebrate our independence as a nation. On July 2, 1776, the Second Continental Congress passed the Lee Resolution, which declared the United Colonies free and independent states. Two days later, the Declaration of Independence was adopted and sent for publication, and ever since, this day has been celebrated as John Adams predicted, "as the day of deliverance, by solemn acts of devotion to God Almighty.... solemnized with pomp and parade, with shows, games, sports, guns, bells, bonfires, and illuminations, from one end of this continent to the other, from this time forward forever more."

Of course, this was not the end of the work of establishing our country. The American Revolution had to be fought, and when independence was won, the Constitution of the United States had to be written. The Constitution describes the constraints of our government, and sets forth rights that belong to citizens, which the government cannot justly curb. The First Amendment to the Constitution says this: "Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances." The first clause of this amendment is known as the Establishment Clause, which prevents the federal government from creating a national church, or favoring one religion over another; the Free Exercise guarantees that we might fully practice our religion without fear of reprisal.

However, despite this constitutional guarantee of religious freedom, religious people, and especially Catholics, have long had to fight to protect this freedom. This has been true throughout our history, and is especially true in our time. In recent years, the Supreme Court has regularly engaged in a kind of pseudo-religious anthropology, attempting to define such things as the nature of the human person and the nature of marriage on its own authority, without reference to God, and Congress used the force of law and the coercive power of fines against religious persons when the Affordable Care Act attempted to impose the necessity to provide contraceptive coverage on Christian charities. These incidents and others should remind us that, though our religious freedom is protected by the Constitution, this protection is not unassailable. It is incumbent upon us as Christians to watch for these incursions of the government into the realm of faith, and fight them when they occur. This is the only way to ensure that our freedom of religion is not slowly eroded by sly judicial obfuscation, broken apart by legislative presumption, or otherwise torn away, piece by piece, by the violence of the fallen world.

May the Lord bless and keep you always, and may you have a happy and joyful Independence Day!



PIONEERING SPIRIT ESSAY CONTEST WINNER


