Dear Friends in Christ,

This Friday, the Church will celebrate the Feast Day of St. Andrew, the First Called of the Apostles (as he is commonly called in the Christian east), the brother of St. Peter, and the patron saint of our parish.

We learn in John's Gospel that Andrew was first a disciple of John the Baptist. But John's mission was not to gather disciples for himself; rather, it was to call people to a baptism of repentance in preparation for the coming of the Lord, and to proclaim Him when he came. When the moment arrived, John saw Jesus and pointed him out to his disciples saying, "Behold, the Lamb of God!" Andrew followed after Jesus, and, seeing him follow, Jesus invited Andrew to come to where he was staying. John's Gospel tells us that Andrew spent that afternoon with Jesus, and, although we do not learn the content of their conversation, we know that St. Andrew left Jesus that day convinced he had found the Messiah. He went immediately to his brother Simon and brought him to Jesus. And so the early days of the ministry of Jesus and his disciples began.

Tradition tells us that after the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, Saint Andrew headed east to proclaim the Good News. He went through Asia Minor, along the coast of the Black Sea, through Crimea, as far as Kiev, and so he became the patron of the church in Russia. It was Saint Andrew who founded the See of Byzantium, later Constantinople (now Istanbul). Finally, Andrew arrived in the Greek city of Patras, where he suffered martyrdom by crucifixion upon an X-shaped cross, also known as a saltire, or a St. Andrew's Cross. St. Andrew was buried in Patras, and there he remained until 357 AD, when most of his relics were removed to Constantinople by order of the emperor Constantine. In 1207, following the Fourth Crusade and the Sack of Constantinople, the relics of St. Andrew were taken to Amalfi, Italy, and later, some of the relics, including the skull, were taken to St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. In September of 1964, Paul VI returned these relics to Patras, where they are now enshrined at the Greek Orthodox Cathedral of St. Andrew. Relics of St. Andrew are also housed in Scotland at the National Shrine of St. Andrew in Edinburg, Scotland, where St. Andrew is also patron saint and the national flag is a white St. Andrew's Cross on a field of blue.

As Catholic Christians, our devotion to the saints is a vital part of our faith. We believe in the Communion of Saints, that we still have communion with those who have passed away, that the saints in Heaven lift up our needs and prayers before the Lord, and that we must pray for the departed souls who are being purified through Purgatory to be welcomed into the light of heaven. And so, as we celebrate the feast day of our patron, let us lift up all our prayers to the Lord, for ourselves, for our parish family, and for the universal Church, through the intercession of St. Andrew, and remember to pray for all our departed brothers and sisters from St. Andrew's, that the Lord will welcome them into the light of his face.

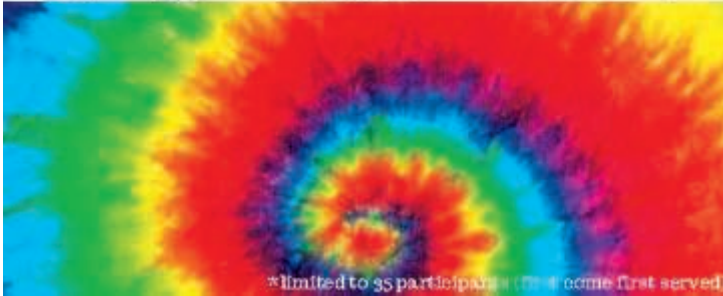

prayer that is repeated over a series of days. That is the case with one of the most beloved of all Advent devotions, the Saint Andrew Christmas Novena. The Saint Andrew Christmas Novena is often called simply the "Christmas Novena" or the "Christmas Anticipation Prayer," because it is prayed 15 times every day from the Feast of Saint Andrew the Apostle (November 30) until Christmas. It is an ideal Advent devotion; the First Sunday of Advent is the Sunday closest to the Feast of Saint Andrew. While the novena is tied to the Feast of Saint Andrew, it is not actually addressed to Saint Andrew but to God Himself, asking Him to grant our request in honor of the birth of His Son at Christmas. You can say the prayer all 15 times, all at once; or divide-up the recitation as necessary (perhaps five times at each meal).

Each year, during Respect Life Month (in Oct) established by the National Conference of Catholic Bishops, students and staff at St Andrew Catholic School are asked to participate in the celebration of Respect Life Month. This year, our school family raised \$1,067 for the cause. Most importantly, our prayer warriors said 1,050 Rosaries for life during the month. Pictured above are two precious 1st graders. Their class raised the most money in our school for the cause and earned a "dress-down" day. Thank you, John Kost, for being a fine example and leading us in the crusade for life. We appreciate all who keep us in their prayers daily!

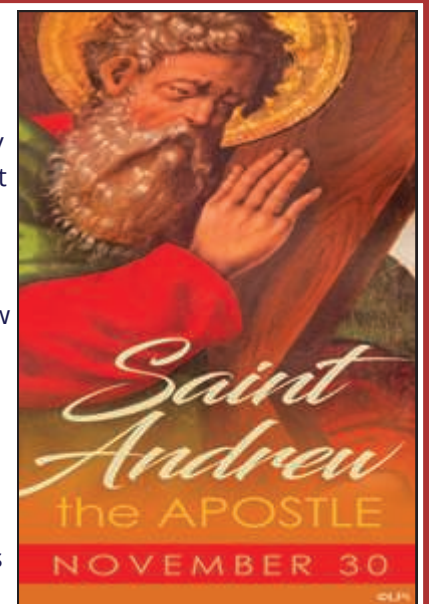

IGLESIA CATÓLICA DE SAN ANDRÉS

25 de noviembre de 2018

Queridos amigos en Cristo,

Este viernes, la Iglesia celebrará el día, la fiesta de San Andrés, el primer llamado de los apóstoles (como comúnmente se le llama en el oriente cristiano), el hermano de San Pedro y el santo patrón de nuestra parroquia.

Aprendemos en el Evangelio de Juan que Andrés fue primero un discípulo de Juan el Bautista. Pero la misión de Juan no era reunir discípulos para sí mismo; más bien, fue para llamar a la gente a un bautismo de arrepentimiento en preparación para la venida del Señor, y para proclamarlo cuando vino. Cuando llegó el momento, Juan vio a Jesús y lo señaló a sus discípulos diciendo: "¡Miren, el Cordero de Dios!" Andrés siguió a Jesús. Jesús al ver a Andrés que lo seguía lo invitó a acompañarlo. El Evangelio de Juan nos dice que Andrés pasó esa tarde con Jesús y, aunque no aprendemos el contenido de su conversación, sabemos que San Andrés ese día se convenció de que había encontrado al Mesías. Inmediatamente fue a su hermano Simón y lo llevó a Jesús. Y así comenzaron los primeros días del ministerio de Jesús y sus discípulos.

La tradición nos dice que después de la venida del Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés, San Andrés se dirigió al este para proclamar la Buena Nueva. Pasó por Asia Menor, a lo largo de la costa del Mar Negro, por Crimea, hasta Kiev, y se convirtió en el patrón de la iglesia en Rusia. Fue San Andrés quien fundó la Sede de Bizancio, más tarde Constantinopla (ahora Estambul). Finalmente, Andrés llegó a la ciudad griega de Patras, donde sufrió el martirio por crucifixión en una cruz en forma de X, también conocida como saltire o Cruz de San Andrés. San Andrés fue enterrado en Patras, y allí permaneció hasta el 357 dC, cuando la mayoría de sus reliquias fueron trasladadas a Constantinopla por orden del emperador Constantino. En 1207, después de la Cuarta Cruzada y el Saco de Constantinopla, las reliquias de San Andrés fueron llevadas a Amalfi, Italia, y más tarde, algunas de las reliquias, incluida la calavera, fueron llevadas a la Basílica de San Pedro en Roma. En septiembre de 1964, Pablo VI devolvió estas reliquias a Patras, donde ahora están consagradas en la catedral ortodoxa griega de San Andrés. Las reliquias de San Andrés también se encuentran en Escocia en el Santuario Nacional de San Andrés en Edinburgo, Escocia, donde San Andrés también es santo patrono y la bandera nacional es una cruz blanca de San Andrés en un campo de azul.

Como cristianos católicos, nuestra devoción a los santos es parte vital de nuestra fe. Creemos en la Comunión de los Santos, que todavía tenemos comunión con aquellos que han fallecido, que los santos en el Cielo elevan nuestras necesidades y oraciones ante el Señor, y que debemos orar por las almas difuntas que están siendo purificadas a través del Purgatorio. Para ser bienvenidos a la luz del cielo. Y así, al celebrar el día de la fiesta de nuestro patrón, elevemos todas nuestras oraciones al Señor, por nosotros mismos, por nuestra familia parroquial y por la Iglesia universal, a través de la intercesión de San Andrés, y recuerden orar por todos nuestros hermanos y hermanas difuntos de San Andrés, que el Señor les dará la bienvenida a la luz de su rostro.
