Dear Friends in Christ,

As many of you know, I am an adult convert to the Catholic faith. I accepted the truth of the Gospel and professed Jesus as Lord on September 4th, 2004, in a spiritual experience of conversion that many Protestant Christians refer to as getting saved, or being born-again. And for many Protestants, this is all that is necessary for one to consider oneself a fully-fledged Christian. However, I also knew that I was not a Protestant, and that I intended to follow the Lord in the One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church. But I knew very little about how to make this new-found faith and conviction a reality. How does one become a Catholic?

To find the answer to this question, I soon approached my local parish and asked what I needed to do to join the Catholic Church. The staff welcomed me, and asked me about my religious background. Had I been baptized? No. In that case, I would need to receive the Sacraments of Initiation, Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist; and in order to prepare to receive these sacraments, I must participate in what is called the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults, or R.C.I.A for short.

The next few months I spent in R.C.I.A were vital and formative for me, and I am still in touch with many of the friends I made at that time. The classes were helpful for learning many particulars of the faith (what do Catholics believe about Mary? Why do Catholics pray for the dead, or through the intercession of the Saints?), but perhaps more helpful ultimately was the opportunity to find friendship and support from Catholics who had spent their whole lives walking with the Lord Jesus, and learning from them the joy of the Christian life.

Here at St. Andrew's, we are beginning this year a new class for the preparation of those who wish to enter the Church through R.C.I.A, which we will call *Come and See*, invoking the invitation of the Lord to our patron Saint Andrew to come and be with the Lord. This class is intended for those who wish to enter the Catholic church who have either never been baptized or were baptized in a Protestant tradition. It is often the case that a Catholic spouse will be married to someone who grew up in a Protestant tradition, but now the non-Catholic spouse has been coming to Mass for years. The R.C.I.A and *Come and See* can help these non-Catholic spouses be fully received into the Church, and so bring the unity in the Sacrament the Lord desires. Also, this class is for those who were baptized as Catholics but, for whatever reason, were never Confirmed. This class will prepare them to receive Confirmation this Easter and the Gifts of the Spirit that it brings.

But *Come and See* is for all those who are fully initiated Catholics who wish to continue with their study of the faith, or brush up on their Catholicism 101 knowledge. The presence of strong Catholics who can serve as mentors and sponsors to the fledglings is a vital ministry of welcome and accompaniment, which those being received will remember for years to come. I am certainly grateful for all the prayers and support that I received by the Catholics who ministered to me through R.C.I.A, and I remember them in prayer always.

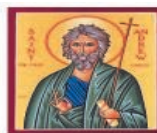

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

Este año hemos estado reflexionando sobre algunas tradiciones latinoamericanas de nuestra fe. Creo que sería bueno reflexionar también sobre lo que es la Tradición y lo que son las tradiciones. En muchas ocasiones durante mi formación religiosa mis maestros me advertían de no confundir la Tradición en mayúscula con la tradición en minúscula.

“¿Cuál es la diferencia?”, preguntaba. Y de seguro algunos de ustedes se lo estarán preguntando también. Según el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica (CIC 75-83) los Apóstoles transmitieron el Evangelio de Jesucristo de manera escrita y de manera oral. El Evangelio escrito nos ha llegado en forma del Nuevo Testamento, en especial por los cuatro evangelios. El Evangelio oral nos ha llegado por lo que llamamos la Tradición; ésta nos llega por la predicación, la vida y el ejemplo de los Apóstoles.

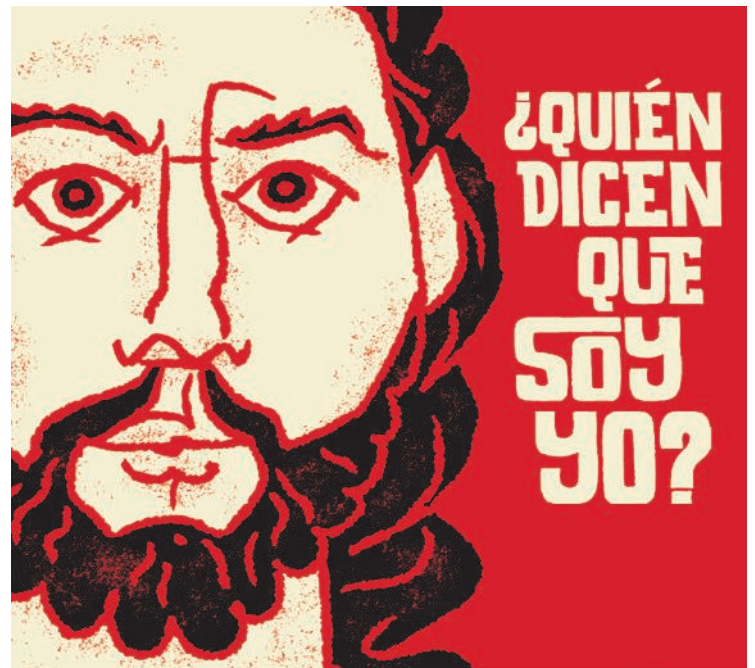
